**Children and youths are kindly invited to attend creative workshops:
drawing and painting, taking photos and creating video clips together**

The society “Cooperation Platform” kindly invites children from the age of 7 and youths to participate in creative workshops. In the course of studies children and youths will master skills and habits of drawing and painting, photography, creating video clips and the use of modern technologies in creative processes. The participants will be encouraged to develop their imagination and enthusiastically create versions, images and stories of their own connected with problems of integration which are so essential nowadays.

The children of the subjects of the third countries and of permanent alien residents are kindly invited to participate in the workshops for the purpose of mastering Latvian as well as the culture and traditions of the country in nonformal atmosphere.

In the run of the studies the students, using modern multimedia technologies, will create a video clip based on their own pictures, drawings, photos and video materials and it will serve as a guide to mastering Latvian. The video clip will be published in the Internet and sent out to Latvian Embassies and missions abroad. This video material will be created in Latvian with English and Russian interpretations. The creative classes are planned to be held twice a week: on Tuesdays from 17.30 till 19.30 and on Saturdays from 11.00 till 13.00 in the building of NGO(42 Laimdotas street – entrance from Ieriķu street). The creative workshops will be in function for 4 months, t.i. up to the middle of April. The opening workshop is to be held on January 13, 2015 at 17.30.

The classes will be conducted by highly-experienced professional artists Andris Stripkāns, Kaspars Berziņš and Martiņš Urķis. The classes are free of charge.

The creative classes have been organized for the purpose of providing and popularizing the opportunity for the children of the subjects of the third countries and of permanent alien residents to explore and supplement their imagery of Latvian history and culture as well as to create the concept of integration problems.

The classes have been organized by the society “Cooperation Platform” within the framework of the project “Integration ABC – 2”.

Children and young people taking interest in the project are kindly invited to enter for participation in advance till January 13, 2015.
